³NUR 301 is reserved for students in the College of Nursing and students applying to the Accelerated Second-Degree BSN. Students who are not in these programs are encouraged to check CMU’s website for equivalencies at other institutions. BLD 204 needs PSL 310 or PSL 431 as a prerequisite. BLD 204 is not open to students with senior status (88 credits or above).

⁴Students must contact individual schools to determine what they consider acceptable as Direct Patient Care. Students should also discuss with schools the deadline for completion of Direct Patient Care hours.

⁵Any of the following immunology courses will fulfill the upper-level physiology requirement for WSU: BLD 434, MGI 451, MGI 409, MGI 413
